
How to Pray



The Asian-Pacific Rim includes China, Mongolia, the Koreas, Japan, Thailand, Myanmar, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Indonesia, the Philippines, Malaysia and Taiwan. Of the population of 2.3 billion people, 95% are living in spiritual darkness. But because of the hard work of missionaries, thousands are hearing the Gospel and accepting Christ and new churches are being planted.

How to Pray
