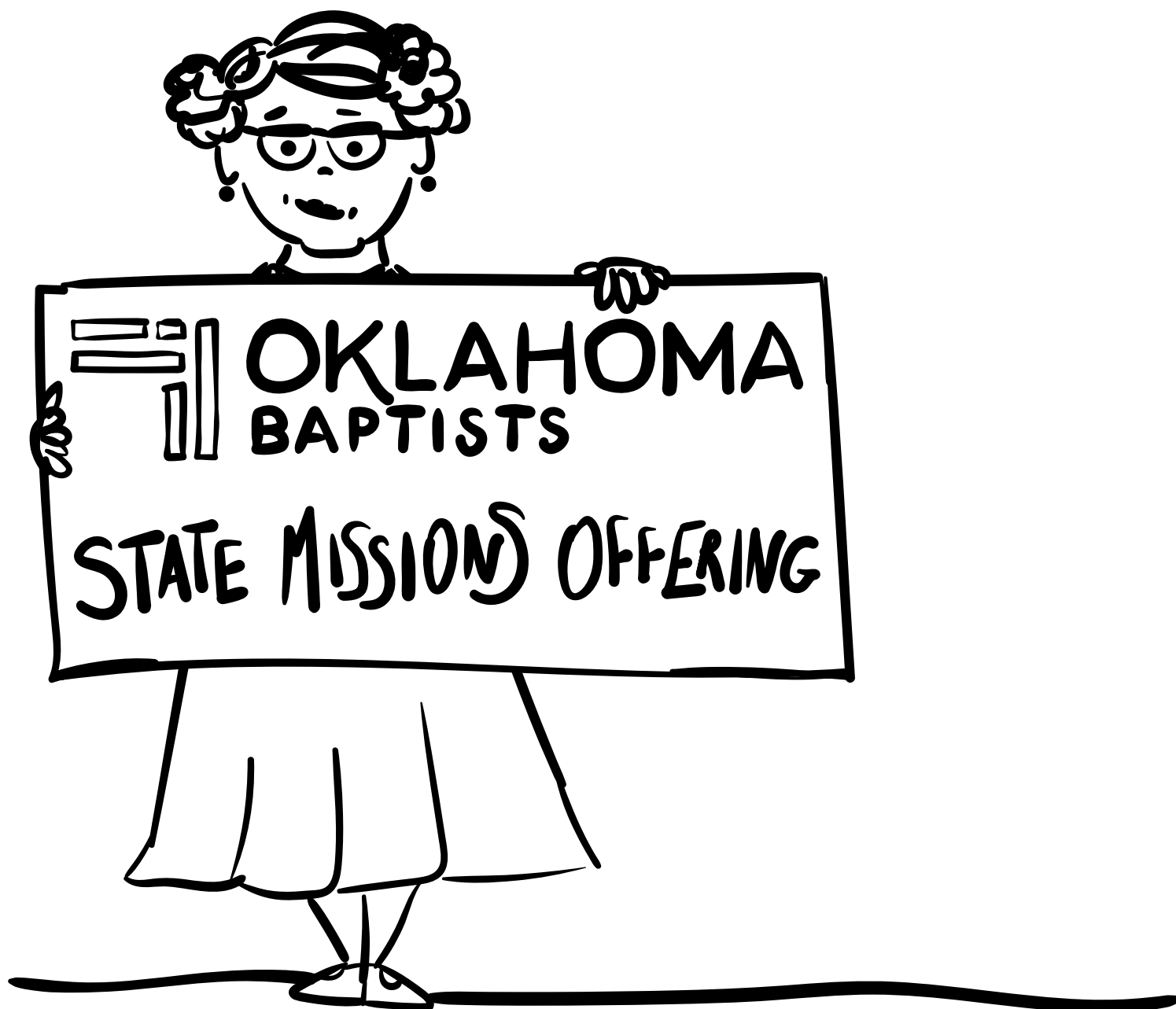

Ninety-three years ago, I was elected to be the President of the Oklahoma Woman's Missionary Union (or you can call it WMU). I spent my time encouraging Oklahoma Baptist churches to tell their neighbors and community about Jesus. In 1939, the Oklahoma State Missions Offering was named after me. Each year, families give their money to help hurting people know about Jesus.

I have two friends I want you to meet. They love telling others about Jesus!

Miss Annie Armstrong started missions in North America. She's awesome! During Easter, churches give money so that people on our continent (places like the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico) will hear that Jesus loves them.

During the Christmas season, churches collect an offering so that missionaries can tell people about Jesus all around the world.
