It's how nearly 50,000 Southern Baptist churches work together to fund missions and ministries locally and globally.

Thousands hear the Gospel and many are called into ministry.

Supporting Oklahoma Baptist Homes for Children, OBU, WatersEdge, and Baptist Village Communities.

### **Disaster Relief**

In 2024, volunteers shared the Gospel 32,000+ times with 8,561 professions of faith.

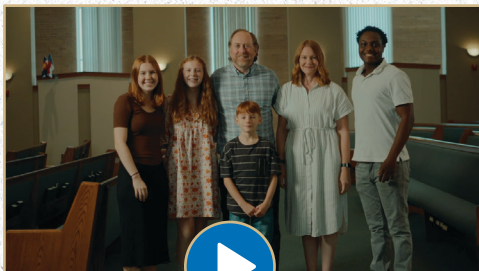
